Heavy rainfall outlook due to Southwest Monsoon

(50 – 100 mm)	Zambales, Bataan, Occidental Mindoro, and Palawan	Metro Manila, Bataan, Pangasinan, Tarlac, Pampanga, Bulacan, Cavite, Batangas, Quezon, Oriental Mindoro, Palawan, Romblon, Marinduque, and Antique	Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan,	 Localized flooding is possible mainly in areas that are urbanized, low lying, or near rivers. Landslide possible in highly susceptible areas.

Forecast rainfall may be higher in mountainous and elevated areas. Moreover, impacts in some areas may be worsened by significant antecedent rainfall.

The public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to take all necessary measure to protect life and property. PAGASA Regional Services Division may issue Heavy Rainfall Warnings, Rainfall/Thunderstorm Advisories, and other severe weather information specific to their areas of responsibility as appropriate.

Unless significant changes occur, the next Weather Advisory will be issued at 5:00 PM today.
